Extra Hardware

- Braille Embosser (+ DBT Software)
- Braille Display
- Digital Magnifier

Software Differences

- JAWS is automatically ON at login and for all users. This is a profile setting that can be turned off for students who do not use JAWS.

Troubleshooting / Helping

- Students unable to find equipment when it gets moved
- Speakers get turned off by students who don't use JAWS
- Embosser – turning it on, feeding paper

Scheduling

- Other rooms should be scheduled before this one to keep it open for students with low vision / blindness

HELP FOR MOBILITY IMPAIRMENTS (AT200A)

Extra Hardware

- Gooseneck Microphone (clamped to the table)
- Touchpad Mouse
- Proximity Keycard Scanner

Help Needed


- Help opening door, moving furniture, plugging in equipment
- Position table height and equipment to student preference
- Wait to make sure microphone & mouse are working & Dragon starts
- Make sure auto door opener is not blocked so they can get out
